Recent Day Classes

At the beginning of June we welcomed Toni Watts to our studio. I can tell you if you thought about joining this class and then didn't you really missed a fabulous course!

23ct Gold leaf and painting, not the usual thing that you expect from Golden Hinde but it was really fascinating. We have 6 people on the course and we all did different things. Toni is so knowledgeable and gave us lots of information about the history of the techniques, we learnt about the different products used to apply the gold leaf and the best ways to apply them. We then proceeded to create our own masterpiece.













On Day 2 Toni upped the difficulty, we attempted to create raised gold leaf, this sounds easier than it is, and in fact the technique is straight forward that is if the products play ball. There were two main choices of product (of glue) one the traditional Gesso and another more modern equivalent, I personally really wanted to love Gesso but it was difficult, the main reason probably being that the air was too dry (the weather was quite nice) and the ideal would be for the air to be slightly damp. We all managed to complete at least 1 piece of work for each day, some of which can be seen above.







We also welcomed the welcomed the wonderful Tanya Bentham to our studio on the 20th and 21st June. Tanya teaches medieval embroidery and Opus Anglicanum, We were completeing an angel and we were given a choice of hair colour - ginger, blonde or black - the stitched mainly consisted of split stitch, the thickness of your silk created the definition and depth of colour to an area. We started with the collar of her dress, out lines and the hair, then moved on to the eyes. When we moved on to filling the face, this required a little more artistic skill and forward thinking to create the contours, and shape of the face in the right areas - I definitely found the hair and collar easier. We outlined the side of the face her chin, nose and eyebrows, this gave her some definition and an expression. It really was amazing how different everyone's pieces looked just by differing how many strands used of each colour in the hair and which order they were used in.

We were really looking forward to learning underside couching for the halo, using a gold passing thread (or a 371 as an alternative) and a strong think thread for couching, as a lot of pressure is put on the thread which can lead to snapping. We practiced the technique and some of us found it easier than others as it takes a little getting used to, and it is very time consuming as both threads need to be handled with care to limit damage and breakages to both threads.

Stitch along

We have made a decision to take a short break and will release new stitch along's in September and we will announce them on our social media channels and in our newsletters.
